## Accommodations

High Country Properties Resort in Panorama, B.C.  
Thursday, June 7 until Monday, June 11  
(Check in: 4 p.m.; Check out: 11 a.m.)  
Site Numbers P1801 (Greywolf Forest Ridge)  
and P1810 (Greywolf Wildwood)

The units can hold 10 people each, and include all linens, towels, dishes, and paper products, and feature a full kitchen, hot tub, BBQ, deck, TV/ DVD, fire place, one pool table and one air hockey table. Nearby in the resort there is restaurants, pubs, night club, liquor and convenience store, sauna, swimming pool, tennis courts, and climbing wall. (This is for information only ... I don't recommend any of us take up swimming or climbing with all the pub crawling, card playing, pool shooting, and yes, golfing, that we normally do.) For you smokers, properties are designated non-smoking. Smoking is permitted outside on decks and patios.

The resort overlooks the Greywolf Golf Course which is a 3 hour drive from Calgary. To find your way to the course and resort, you need to travel Hwy 93/95 and turn into Invermere on the lake. Follow the road into town, and turn right at the sign directing you to Panorama Mountain Village. It's about 18 km along this road from Invermere ... follow the signs. (That's the best I can tell you, and yes, I got lost last year looking for our condo in Whitefish ... damn Mapquest!)

## Golf Rule Book Changes for 2007

1. RULE 4 (7a): If a putt passes over a hole without dropping, it is deemed to have dropped. The law of gravity supersedes the law of golf.
2. RULE 5: Putts that stop close enough to the cup that they could be blown in, may be blown in. This does not apply to balls more than three inches from the hole. No one wants to make a travesty of the game.
3. RULE 6.a.9(k): There is no penalty for so-called "out of bounds." If penny-pinching golf club owners bought sufficient land, this would not occur. The golfer deserves an apology, not a penalty.
